Climate Change Legislation feature topic at Chamber Luncheon

Climate Change S.J. Resolution 26 and H.J. Resolution 76 would reject an EPA finding that greenhouse gases endanger human health and welfare and therefore should be regulated by the EPA under the auspices of the Clean Air Act (CAA). EPA said that it plans to use CAA to regulate all emitters, large and small. EPA regulation of greenhouse gases could impose federal permitting requirements on millions of businesses, restrict fuel choices and energy use, and require expensive installation of new equipment for businesses of all sizes, including small businesses. The resolutions would halt EPA's efforts to expand the CAA beyond its intended boundaries.

The US Chamber strongly supports both resolutions. It remains supportive of passing climate change legislation this year and believes that these resolutions will give Congress the time it needs to get this important issue right. What do you think?
