Nominations for the three 2010 Pacesetter Awards will be accepted through July 29. The three award categories are:

The Edward J. Parish Pacesetter shall be a living person who:

- Is a member of the business community, and whose business is a member of the Clermont Chamber of Commerce.
- Performs services for the county, which are voluntary, continued and devoted in nature and/or promotes a business culture in which community support is encouraged.
- Has attained professional, business or civic distinction at local, state, national or international levels.
- Has held multiple leadership positions within business and civic organizations,
- Has brought favorable attention to the community and/or business through his or her accomplishments.

The Corporate Pacesetter shall be a company that:

- Currently conducts business in and is physically located in the geographic borders of Clermont County, and is a member of the Clermont Chamber of Commerce.
- Has demonstrated a business culture that promotes volunteerism and continued community support that other companies can model for success.
- Has brought favorable attention to the community and/or business through its accomplishments.

The Martha Dorsey Public Servant Pacesetter shall be an elected or non-elected public official, not currently serving or a candidate to serve, whom:

- Represents Clermont County.
- Has demonstrated leadership that has improved the economic vitality of Clermont County.
- Has brought favorable attention to the community through his or her accomplishments.
